Official Kanji Test in Lille

kanji kentei

Kanji Kentei is a test that checks the *kanji* level of candidates, it is organised at set dates in Japan and many other cities around the world. At first, the test was designed for Japanese people themselves, but anybody can try it and more and more foreigners attempt it.

Among the twelve levels available, from 10 to 1 (plus 2 intermediate levels: pre-2 and pre-1), the first 3 levels (10, 9 and 8) are the easiest and therefore recommended to foreigners, even though you can attempt all levels if you wish to. The test is recognised as an official diploma by *Monbukagakushô*, the Japanese Ministry of Education and Culture.

The test is made up of a series of questions that aim at assessing your knowledge of *kanji*. You will be asked on the various readings, stroke order and compound words.
